

## **SCHOOL TRACK ACCOMPLISHMENTS 2007**

The following is a list of accomplishments by some of our youth track athletes, while competing for their respective middle-school and high-schools this past track season.

### **Madison Mayleben**

On May 23rd, Madison Mayleben took first in all three of her track events as a seventh grader at Ann Arbor's Slauson Middle school. The most impressive one was the 800 she ran, in which she was far out ahead of the pack.

### **Drake Johnson**

Drake Johnson set the broke the Slauson 55 m Hurdle record this past spring. It was 8.3.....he ran 8.19. Drake is .03 from breaking the 200 m Hurdle record also. It is 28.1, he ran 28.4. Drake also runs on the 4 x 400 meter relay team there, like his brother (Carter) did. The last time Slauson won City Championship was 2 years ago and only in that 4 x 400 race, which Carter ran 3rd leg in.

### **Carter Johnson**

Carter Johnson broke the Freshman record in both 110 hurdles and 300 hurdles at Ann Arbor's Huron High School with times of 16.9 and 43.5.

### **Shannon Jackson**

Shannon Jackson is a graduating senior from Howell High School, and her accomplishments for her high school career are:

- PR's: 100M (12.5), 200M (26.5), 400M (59)
